Sessions I & II

Alpine (Skiing, Snowboarding, or Telemark) Please meet the instructors behind the Indian Peaks lodge promptly at 9:30am. Each instructor and the ability level they will be teaching will be announced upstairs in the Indian Peaks lodge during breakfast on the first day of each session. When you arrive behind the Indian Peaks Lodge Eldora staff will help you find the instructor who is teaching your ability level.

Nordic (Skate or Classic) Please meet your instructor at the Nordic Center located in the southeast corner of the lower parking lot promptly at 9:30am. Please remember you will need to allow yourself time to drive, walk, or ski to get from the Indian Peaks Lodge to the Nordic center by 9:30am.

All Participants When meeting at your designated location at 9:30am have all of your equipment with you, including your ski pass. Be dressed, ready to ski or ride. Please be sure you have chosen the level that describes your skiing or riding abilities AT THIS TIME, not what you would like to work towards. Each instructor will verbally assess the group prior to departure to the lift or trails and then proceed to the terrain that best suits the group for an on snow assessment.

****The Women's Program is non-refundable and there are no make-up lessons for missed days. Skiing is a winter sport involving freezing temperatures, wind, and snow. Eldora does not cancel lessons due to extreme weather conditions or winter driving conditions. Please dress appropriately and allow yourself a sufficient amount of time to drive to Eldora.**

- Instructors will do their best to group classes according to skill level, common goals, and confidence.
- Instructors will do their best to give individual feedback, but sometimes feedback may be directed to benefit the entire group.
